

Mutual cooperation agreement between organisations

Organisations can apply for organisational grants provided by the Western Uusimaa Wellbeing Services County together with eligible applicants and implement the operations jointly. In joint operations, the applicants can agree upon the lead applicant to whom the grant is paid and who is responsible for reporting on the use of the grant. Applicants may also agree upon the distribution of the grant and the reporting responsibility between the applicants participating in the operations.

Those applying for organisational grants must conclude a mutual cooperation agreement on applying for organisation grants provided by the wellbeing services county. Those applying for organisation grants may use this cooperation agreement template when applying for a grant related to their joint operations.
