How we serve you in student welfare services

Non-urgent messages

You may send us a non-urgent message at any time of the day.

Response within three business days. Allows you to message a familiar professional, for instance.

School and student health care

 Non-urgent message to school and student health care

School social worker services

 Non-urgent message to school social workers from 25 September 2025 onward

Psychologist services

 Non-urgent message to psychologists from 28 January 2026 onward

In urgent situations, contact a professional by phone during office hours

from 25 September 2025 onward

School social worker services

from 25 September 2025 onward

Psychologist services

from 28 January 2026 onward

Wilma messages from student welfare services with the introduction of Lunna

With the introduction of Lunna, we will only communicate general student welfare matters via Wilma.

In the future, we will not use Wilma for confidential communications related to client and patient data.

Clients have access to:

- Lunna
 - non-urgent messages have been used by school and student health care since 9 April 2025
 - non-urgent messages will become available for school social worker services of student welfare as of 25 September 2025
 - for psychologist services of student welfare as of 28 January 2026
- · Secure email from turvaposti.luvn.fi
- Phone (call or text message)
- Open receptions with a public health nurse, psychologist or school social worker
- · School and student health care also use electronic booking



Getting started with Lunna

Channel:

Lunna mobile app from AppStore or GooglePlay



Suomi.fi identification:

- Online banking codes
- Mobile certificate
- Certificate card

Start using the service:

- Access to all services after identification
- Opportunity to use services for those living outside Western
 Uusimaa Wellbeing Services County (e.g., living outside the
 area but child's/young person's educational institution is in the
 wellbeing services county)
- Anonymous chat, i.e., using services without logging in: Only general advice on wellbeing services county's services, possible via a web browser in the Lunna digital services platform's chat.





Acting on behalf of another person in Lunna

1. Acting on behalf of another person in Lunna is based on Suomi.fi e-Authorizations

- The right automatically granted by your role (e.g., if you are the guardian of a person under the age of 18, you do not need an authorisation) or
- · Suomi.fi e-Authorization for managing matters related to health and social welfare

2. You can act on behalf of people added to your profile in Lunna

 All persons must be manually added as persons on whose behalf you may act to your profile using a Suomi.fi process launched via Lunna before you can act on behalf of another person.

3. Children on whose behalf you are acting may have their own active profiles in Lunna

- Even if, for example, a 15-year-old child had their own online banking codes and their own Lunna profile, their quardian can still manage their affairs in Lunna.
- The young person's own messages are not visible to the guardian, and the messages their guardian sends on their behalf are not visible to the young person.

4. If you cannot see any dependents on the platform, you can

- Use Suomi.fi e-Authorization online (or at the Digital and Population Data Services Agency's service point)
- And/or add the person on whose behalf you will be acting to your own profile in Lunna.
